About the Museum

The Children's Museum is an educational, cultural, and social learning center for children and families from the Metro South region of Massachusetts. Located in The Old Fire Station, our mission is to inspire a life long love of learning in children by stimulating curiosity and motivating learning through play and hands-on experience. The Museum has three floors of interactive exhibits as well as an outdoor learning center and hosts a variety of classes programs and events throughout the year. Over 50,000 people visit annually.

Job Description: Volunteer Position

Interns plan, organize and lead STEM activities in the Museum's **MakerSpace** and during Museum events and programs. Activities are designed to teach STEM concepts using everyday items as well as special tools, and encourage exploration and experimentation.

Duties

The Education intern directs kids ages 3 – 8 and their families in one (or more) STEM Activity, working either one-on-one or in small groups. This involves:

- Planning and organizing weekly activities.
- Plan and organize activities to be integrated into Museum programs and special events.
- Providing basic instructions.
- Helping kids to share their ideas.
- Asking questions and encouraging kids to use familiar materials in unfamiliar ways.
- Set up and clean up of materials.

Position requirements

- Excellent communication skills.
- Flexibility to lead and develop projects in a variety of settings.
- Able to work in a fun environment with parents, children and Museum staff.
